Local Notice to Mariners 50/19

Temporary Suspension of the Wick Channel Traffic Lights

Mariners are advised that the marine traffic lights which control access and egress through the Wick Channel are temporarily set to Red at both the Southern and Northern ends of the Wick Channel.

Mariners should still adhere to the requirements to contact Port Control before entering the Wick Channel. Port Control will continue to facilitate and manage the movement of vessels through the Wick Channel and will instruct vessels to proceed against the traffic light signals with caution when it is safe to do so.

Mariners are reminded to navigate with caution when manoeuvring in the vicinity, whilst maintaining a listening watch on VHF CH 74 and take instructions as required from Dover VTS on VHF Ch 74.
